Từ **opened** (B) phát âm “-ed” /d/, 3 từ còn lại phát âm /t/. → Đáp án: **B**.

- father /'fɑːðər/ → âm /ɑː/ (dài)
- cat /kæt/ → âm /æ/
- hat /hæt/ → âm /æ/
