- **Đáp án: B. had**

Question 13: Jane seldom goes out at night, _____ she?

- Câu gốc là “Jane seldom goes out at night” → Thì hiện tại đơn dạng phủ định hoặc tần suất thấp → đuôi khẳng định: “does she?”
- **Đáp án: A. does**

Question 14: If he _____ harder, he would have passed the entrance exam.

- Mệnh đề “would have passed” → câu điều kiện loại 3 → if + had + V3/ed
- **Đáp án: C. had studied**

Question 15: Computers, as well as smart devices, _____ become essential tools...

- Chủ ngữ chính “Computers, as well as smart devices,” → về ngữ nghĩa là “Computers ... have become...” → động từ chia số nhiều: have
- **Đáp án: D. have**

- **Đáp án: B. in order to**

- “until he comes back” (khi nói ở hiện tại) → thì Hiện tại đơn sau “until” (mệnh đề thời gian tương lai → chia hiện tại).
- **Đáp án: A. comes**

- Mất điện thoại → điều đó thật tiếc → “What a pity!”
- **Đáp án: B. What a pity!**
