

Banh Chung is a traditional Vietnamese rice cake, especially important during Tet, the Vietnamese Lunar New Year. This square cake is made from sticky rice, mung beans, and pork, all wrapped in green leaves, usually dong leaves. These leaves give the cake its green color and special taste. Banh Chung has a long history in Vietnam and represents gratitude to ancestors and the **abundance** of nature.

Making Banh Chung is a careful process that often involves the whole family. First, the sticky rice and mung beans are soaked overnight. 
